RIDDEN TEST.

- A 20 metre circle in trot on both reins.
- Lengthening of the stride in trot for at least 20 metres.
- A circle in canter on each rein, with strike-off from working trot.
- A minimum of 20 metres in medium walk and a minimum of 20 metres lengthening the stride in walk, lengthening the neck of the horse, as well as its top line.
- This test must be performed in a snaffle bridle, or a double bridle for horses over 6 years old, whip and spurs optional, with rising trot being permitted.
